

MYRINGOTOMY WITH TUBES

- Cleanse the outer ear with a washcloth. **DO NOT** use cotton swabs such as Q-Tips. **DO NOT** rinse out the ear at any time.
- Use Tylenol or Motrin for discomfort as directed on the package.
- DO NOT** let your child go swimming until cleared by your child's physician.
- Please call to make the appointment for your child to see his/her physician in approximately two (2) weeks following the surgery:

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS:

- Your child may feel sleepy or nauseated for a short period of time. If needed, your child may have medication to relieve the nausea.
- Your child may have discomfort in one or both ears.

CONTACT YOUR CHILD'S PHYSICIAN:

- If your child has pus or blood draining from one or both ears
- If your child's pain is not controlled by Tylenol or Motrin
- If your child has a fever greater than 101.5°
- If your child has a low fever that lasts more than 3 days
- If you have any questions or concerns
